ACROSS COUNTY TOURS

SEPTEMBER 26-29, 2017

Door County stretches from about 15 miles south of Sturgeon Bay to the islands that lie off the northern tip of the Door Peninsula. Wisconsin's most conspicuous feature extends like the spout of a teapot into Green Bay and Lake Michigan. Rugged landscape dotted with fishing villages, beaches, farms and orchards resemble New England. It is the Cape Cod of the Midwest!

Day One Board your deluxe Motorcoach and meet your fellow travelling companions as we depart the Twin Cities for DOOR COUNTY. An included coffee stop in Menomonie and continue eastward to Wausau, WI for lunch on own. Arrive late afternoon in Sister Bay, WI for three nights at the OPEN HEARTH LODGE. (CS)

Day Two After an included Deluxe Continental Breakfast at the hotel, a step on guide boards our coach for an all day tour of Door County. Drive through Wisconsin's largest State Park- Peninsula State Park. Experience the beauty of the shores and bluffs on our way to Eagle Bluff Lighthouse. Built in 1868, the living quarters are completely furnished from that era. Learn about life in a Lighthouse as they step back into the 1880's. Stop at Farm Market and sample Wisconsin's Famous Cheddars, homemade jams/jellies/relishes and dried/chocolate covered Cherries. 11:00 AM Enjoy an included lunch at Al Johnson's Swedish Lunch where we dine on Swedish meatballs, Swedish pancakes with lingonberries, beverage and ice cream. This is the restaurant with the goats on their roof. Our next stop is Bjorklunden Stave Chapel. This little gem is patterned after the Stave Chapel in Lillehammer, Norway and is filled with 41 Fresco Painting and beautiful wood carvings. Here we have a guided tour to learn of the dedication and history of the people who built this little gem during World War II. Our last tour stop is at Dan Meunier School House. Dan is a composer, singer and storyteller. His historic schoolhouse doubles as a museum. It is filled with works of art and eclectic antiquities and has become a place to share his love of the creative spirit. Return to the hotel but not before some shopping and browsing at shops at Founder Square in Fish Creek. This evening we enjoy the traditional Fish Boil. Not too worry, they have other entrees besides fish.(CB,L,D)

Day Three Early morning departure for Northport Pier at Gills Rock, WI, the very tip of the Peninsula. Here we board the ferry plus our coach and visit Washington Island. During

the 30-minute ferry ride, our guide will explain the history of the outlying isands, the Lighthouses and give an intro to Washington Island. You will stop at a Danish Mill, see beautiful West Harbor and learn about logging in the 8800's as well as the Niagra Escarpment. Visit a Stave Chapel where we walk the prayer path and have a guided tour of the Chapel. An included lunch of homemade soup/open-faced sandwiches-served Scandinavian style- salad/chips/beverage and choice of homemade pies or cakes which you actually eat first. Afternoon we go "Downtown" where you learn of the Island's school system, library, clinic and Community center. A stop for pictures at the sod-roofed Stabor at A"Den Norske Grenda" where you can explore their hardware store. On to Historic Washington Harbor and Schoolhouse Beach for a stone skipping contest. You will have the opportunity to meet the Islanders and learn about life on an Island. We take the back roads on our way to the Ferry Dock and departfor Sister Bay. Dinner on own. (CB,L)
